A Brief Review of the History of Israel

What most people think about the Arab-Israeli situation is, unfortunately, inaccurate. For the majority, this is more the fault of revisionist historians and a biased media establishment than anything else. There is an old expression in politics and journalism that if you tell a lie often enough, people will believe that it is true and this is the case with the Arab-Israeli conflict.

The "Palestinians" claim a divine right to the land that pre-dates the claim of Israel. They make this claim on the basis of two outright lies. The "Palestinians" say that they are descended from the Philistines, therefore giving them rights to the land that pre-date God's covenant with Abraham. They make a contradictory claim as well—that God's promise to Abraham was to be fulfilled through Ishmael rather than Isaac. Since Ishmael's mother was Sarah's Egyptian handmaid, it would be impossible for the "Palestinians" to be both of Arabic and Philistine decent.

The truth is that the Philistines, according to Jeremiah 47:4 were from the "islands of Caph-tor," likely somewhere in the Aegean Sea. This is corroborated by archeological evidence. Obviously, the Arabic "Palestinians" are not directly descended from the Philistines, who would most likely resemble modern Greeks. The claim of a divine right to the land through Ishmael falls apart in the face of Biblical and historical evidence as well. blessed by God. As the songwriter once wrote, "Count your many blessings, name them one by one. Count your many blessings, see what God hath done." If we are honest and focus on them, the list will soon become very long. We all have been truly blessed beyond measure.

We must praise God and thank Him every day for His goodness, for abundantly providing for our needs, and for keeping us safe in the palm of His hand. Above all, we must humbly thank God for His matchless gift of salvation through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross and resurrection, freely offered to all who choose to reach out by faith alone to receive it.

The Old Testament prophet Jeremiah wrote these words as recorded in Lam. 3:22-23. "The Lord's loving kindnesses indeed never cease, For His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness."

When we rise up each morning, a spirit of praise and thanksgiving should be in our hearts and on our lips. We need to say, 'Thank you Lord for this day You have made. Thank You for allowing me to be a part of it. Help me to rejoice and be glad in it. Show me what You would have me do today that I might do it all for Your honor and glory'.

The psalmist penned these words in Ps. 34:1, "I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth." In Eph. 5:18 the Apostle Paul tells us to thank God always for all things in the name of Jesus our Lord.

Psalm 103:1 instructs us to bless the holy name of the Lord with all that is within us. This scripture simply means we are to be passionate in our thanksgiving, in our praise and in our desire to serve Him. Are we passionate in our desire to honor and serve Him?

Perhaps during the past year we did not allow God to be first in all things of our life. Maybe we have become complacent toward Him, or lack the desire for a person-

-pact aerobic workout, shower and dress for work. And since I worked from 6 am – 8 pm I ate my dinners at work so once I came home, all the time was mine. I'd walk in the door, change into my exercise gear and have another great time working out and then I'd shower and enjoy my evening. I felt healthy, energetic and alive! And then I made the decision to return to school for my degree and the excuses came out like a flood, "I worked hard all day and now I just HAVE to study. I'll exercise tomorrow." As the excuses piled up, so did the pounds. One day turned into a week, a week into a month and a month into 10 years. Yes, ten years. I went from Ms. Health Nut, to "Dr. Chubby." I then fell into the trap many of us do, I looked for that quick fix. In order to drop all the weight I gained, I tried fad diets, pills, and you name it. Most fad diets are very unhealthy! The Adkins diet for one recommends that you eat fat, well, scientifically and more importantly, according to scripture, the human body was not designed by our Creator to digest fat. When we consume things that our body was not designed to consume, we see the adverse affects in our health such as stroke, diabetes, obesity, heart disease, and many more bad things.

I knew the keys to weight loss and maintenance, but made the excuses not to do them. Now I have wasted many years being unhealthy, sluggish and just not who God made me to be. I look at my life, I look at my health and praise God that I am still alive to make the changes I need in order to live a long and healthy life.

I stayed up late last night closing the books for our company and a commercial came on about health care. The commercial showed a young woman caring for an elderly man that was bed ridden. As I watched, I thought, "well, that'll be me one day.. in bed and needing someone to care for me." And then the vision of Jack La Lanne came into my head. He was born September 26, 1914, that makes him 92!! YES! NINE-TY-TWO! And he is as healthy today as he was as a young man. Jack La Lanne has always advocated both exercise and a proper diet. Denise Austin, a personal trainer for many American's via their television, started under Jack La Lanne.

I've heard people tell me, "but God made this for me to eat." Actually, in the book of Genesis, at the very beginning, he spoke of fruits and vegetables. Much later the Lord introduced meat. However, remember, everything has a purpose. So the Lord told us which meat we can and cannot eat. Some creatures were designed to be the "cleaners" of

the earth. Their bodies created to digest the remains of other animals. These animals are not created for us to eat. No matter how, "white meat" science tells us pork is, a pig is designed to eat the dead. Their bodies are created to break down tissue, healthy and bad. When we consume pork our bodies then consume unhealthy meat and we feel the effects in our daily lives. We are also not designed to eat the scavengers of the Sea such as shrimp and any shellfish. We're sluggish, grumpy and unhealthy.

In our modern fast-paced lives, so many things are pushed aside for what we choose as being most important, healthy food, exercise, and our family, our Creator. Our bodies were not designed for a double whopper with cheese; medical bills come from that type of life choice.

Rather than trying to list all of the bad food, which is simply any animal that is a carnivore (meat eater), let me list the foods the Lord tells us to enjoy. Remember as fresh and raw as



you can make a food choice, the better it is for you. The main foods that are GOOD for you to consume include:

Meats that are good for you (take out ALL the fat) are: beef, lamb, venison, goat, veal, buffalo, elk. Poultry includes: Chicken, turkey, duck, Cornish game hen, eggs (chicken and duck).

Fish: make sure it has scales! Such as: Salmon, Tuna, Scrod, Halibut, Cod, Grouper, Mahi Mahi, Trout, Snapper, etc.

Dairy (organic is best): Goat's milk (yogurt and cheeses), Cows milk and cheeses.

Fats and oils: Peanut oil

Sweeteners: Raw Honey

And the list goes on. The basic rule of thumb to remember is "if God didn't make it, don't eat it." Fresh fruits and vegetables, lean meats, fish and dairy are your best food choices. Our bodies were not designed to eat TV Dinners, Pizza's and McDonald's. If you want to increase

your chances for removing most illnesses it only takes 2 steps, eat right every day and exercise 4-5 days a week. Now I can hear the excuses, "oh you don't know my schedule!" Sure I do, I've lived the corporate hustle-n-bustle schedule long enough to know what it includes. But it doesn't take more than 30 minutes to make a fast salad (using tomatoes, lettuce, spinach leaves), add some frozen vegetables and a nice chicken breast or other meat. Pack them for work like a TV Dinner and reheat. Your set!

Our bodies are a temple of God, by misusing the Lord's great design, your body, your health, and waistline, will suffer. Remember, you did not gain this weight overnight; you will not lose it overnight. And if you fear saggy skin because you have an excessive amount of weight to lose, remember the golden rule: "Exercise makes my skin tighter, my muscles bigger and my fat a thing of the past." If you exercise for 4-5 days a week, and choose to eat the food God made, you can lose a lot of weight, yes over 100 pounds, and your skin will be taught, your body toned, your life changed.

Did you know the Lord promised us good health and long life? Yes, it's true. And when we follow His design for our bodies, we can live a long and healthy life.

Remember to consult with your doctor before starting any diet or exercise program. You may have done a lot of damage to your body already and may need to start off very slowly with walks and then move up to more vigorous exercise. However, the odds of your doctor saying, "no, no, don't eat that salad, I recommend

2 donuts and a coffee for lunch instead," are pretty slim. REMEMBER NEVER TO GO BELOW 1200 CALORIES A DAY!

I pray the Lord be your guide in whatever decision you have made to start off your New Year. Philippians 4:13 "I can do all thing through Christ who gives me strength." Yes, that does include living a healthier life.

If you don't know where to start, I highly recommend, "The Makers Diet" by Dr. Jordin S. Rubin. Every change you make, no matter how small, does matter.

Whether your resolution is to lose weight, stop smoking or any other change you feel you need to make in your life, remember the Lord promises us, "Philippians 4:13 "I can do all thing through Christ who gives me strength."

land through God's protection of Israel by the numerous miracles He has performed on their behalf.

The truth is that there has never been a Palestinian state and Jerusalem has never been the capital of any nation except Israel. The area was home to a number of tribal city-states prior to the arrival of the Israelites around 1410 B.C. It was nearly 400 years until the Israelites were able to form a true, unified nation under King David. Around 920 B.C., the kingdom was divided—the northern 10 tribes became known as Israel with the southern kingdom known as Judah. These names were likely used until 333 B.C. when Alexander the Great conquered the area.

From the time of Alexander the Great until 135 AD, the area was known as Judea. The first occurrence of the "Palestine" moniker came in 135 AD when Emperor Hadrian put down the last of many Jewish revolts under Roman rule. Hadrian was so angered at the propensity for the Jews to rebel, that he completely destroyed Jerusalem then rebuilt it as a Roman city, renaming it Aelia Capitolina. The Jews were forbidden to practice their faith in the new city and the penalty for mentioning the word "Jerusalem" was cruel and severe. As a final insult to the Jews, Hadrian renamed the area "Palestine" in reference to the Jews most persistent and hated enemy—the Philistines.

Fast-forwarding to 1947, the United Nations passed a resolution calling for Jewish and Arab states to be created side-by-side in the disputed area. The city of Jerusalem, claimed as holy by the world's three monotheistic religions, was to be under UN control. The Arabs rejected this agreement and promised to "push the Jews into the sea," a goal still retained by Arab leaders throughout the Middle East.

Israel formally declared independence on May 14, 1948 and had to fight the attacking Arabs for survival for over a year, and in numerous (mostly Arab-initiated) wars since. In 1956, Israel captured the Sinai Peninsula, only to give it back to Egypt via the UN shortly thereafter. In 1967, the Egyptians, Jordanians, Syrians, and Iraqis attacked Israel starting the Six-Day War. After this war, the Israelis captured the Golan Heights, the Sinai, and Jerusalem.

The current Arab regimes are making two major demands of Israel in return for a cessation of terrorist acts. These

demands are a return to the 1949 borders and the "right of return" for hundreds of thousands of Arab "refugees" allegedly forced out of their homes by the Israelis since 1948. The first demand would require Israel retreating from the entire "West Bank" (which Prime Minister Olmert wants to do) as well as giving up control of Jerusalem. The second demand would mean the destruction of the Jewish state by demographics.

The facts regarding the Arab flight has been confirmed numerous times by many Arab leaders, including the current President of the Palestinian Authority...

The "right of return" is the one thing that the Israelis have never (yet) put on the negotiating table. Other than the above explanation, the reason why the Israelis haven't yielded on this is that it is complete fiction. The fact is that the Arabs fled their homes primarily on the orders of their own leaders who wanted them out of the way in order to attack the Israelis. The theory was that the Arabs would quickly and completely destroy the much smaller Israeli army thus allowing those who left to return to their homes.

The facts regarding the Arab flight has been confirmed numerous times by many Arab leaders, including the current President of the Palestinian Authority, Muhammad Abbas (in 1976) and the Secretary-General of the Arab League (in 1951). It has also been confirmed by independent sources such as the 1957 Research Group for European Migration Problems, Time Magazine (May 3, 1948), the Greek Catholic Bishop of Galilee (1949) and a British

police commander in April 1948.

Finally, as much as we all mourn the loss of lives in the area, it is a Biblical fact that this conflict will not be settled until Christ's return. In Genesis 16:12, God speaks to Hagar regarding her son Ishmael: "He shall be a wild donkey of a man, his hand against everyone and everyone's hand against him." Some translations have the second half of this verse as "his hand will be against his brothers all the days of his life." It should be plain to all that this verse clearly describes the current conflict between the Arabs and the Jews (as well as the broader conflict of Islam against Judaism and Christianity).

Regardless of the news (and the often contradictory facts) from the Middle East, it is evident that God is still sovereign and in control of the past, present, and future. As we approach the fulfillment of prophecy and the End Times, it is vital that Christians reach out to and support our Jewish brothers and sisters as we all worship the same One True God. Proof, from the Christian point of view, is found in John 1:1, where we are told that "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God" (ESV). This verse provides conclusive proof that Jesus (referred to as "the Word" in this verse) is truly the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. The main theological difference between Christians and Jews can be summed up in a quote from the A&E television series, "The Naked Archeologist." The show's host, Simcha Jacobovici said in a recent episode: "Jews are waiting for Messiah to come and Christians are waiting for Messiah to come back." Let us all remember to pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6) as we also utter the prayer, "Come Lord Jesus," (Revelation 22:20, ESV).
